Trapping Safety

Trapping is common in the Kodiak Archipelago, and there are no restrictions on where traps can be set to catch fox, beaver, and other smaller mammals. Occasionally, a dog will find itself in a trap. The HSK strongly recommends that pet owners be knowledgeable and prepared to release a trap or snare in case their pet is caught. Snares, foothold traps, and body grip traps are commonly used. Pet owners must be aware that keeping pets under control and in sight while hiking is crucial for their safety.
